Reports and Announcements (regular agenda items)

Principal's Report: Discussed SMMUSD plan and SMASH specific steps regarding social justice initiative: system of self-reflection and learning walk tools regarding social justice focus and implementation of social justice standards. SMASH Some Core 2-4 teachers and Jessica attended the Teaching Tolerance training at the Museum of Tolerance and a Core 1 teacher is signed up to go soon.

Student Reports: Core 3 social studies presentations included historical research, connections to current day implications, demonstrated how to work as a team, and included active audience engagement. In literacy, it is an open genre unit. People are writing songs, poems, fantasy pieces and more.

Core 4 just started "Red Scarf Girl" which talks about China during the cultural revolution and we have been taking notes on imperial China as well. In Science we are doing labs to learn about photosynthesis.

New Business: Review the results of the SMASH K-8 student engagement survey
(To what degree do students feel they have choice in what they learn and how they show it? How do students feel about peer and adult mentoring relationships through school? How interested and engaged do they feel about what they learn at school?) Student responses indicate K-8 that students increasingly know that effort creates ability, and that what they learn is interesting to them. Should we clarify and reword anything for next year's survey? At March meeting, we will review 3rd-8th grade data.
