Reports and Announcements (regular agenda items)

Principal's Report: Site Council members looked at the mockup of the Beautify Earth mural that will be on the SMASH K yard wall facing Ocean Park.

Student Reports: Core 4 is on their final units: Aztecs, Anne Frank, and science lab for DNA matching, and in Project Lead the Way engineering class finishing tollbooth and bridge.

Community Organization Reports (to include but not limited to the following):

PTSA: SuperSMASH carnival and auction is May 19. Attended Food Services Director meeting. Two schools will be piloting cooking from scratch program. And last SMASH PTSA meeting was budget drafting for 18-19.

Old Business:

Peer Mediation update— We have 20-25 trained peer mediators, 2 on the small yard and 2 on the big yard per day so each mediator serves one day a week. Students opt in/refer themselves to the peer assistance. It is voluntary, confidential and impartial. Mediators wear t-shirts or vests and a clipboard. Student mediators will present to the whole school at the beginning of the year either at an assembly or by visiting each classroom to explain how it works. Different ideas for informing parents about this process were discussed.
